

Pendalungan of Indonesia (Southeast Asia)

The Pendalungan (also identified as the Jawa-Madura or Jawara people) people reside in the eastern portion of East Jawa (Java). The center of their region is the Jember Municipality. The Pendalungan economic life is centered on farming and raising livestock. Their main crop is rice, which is grown in irrigated rice fields. They typically cultivate fruit, vegetables, and other crops planted as secondary crops during the dry season. The majority of Pendalungan people are Muslims. However, in their daily lives they still heavily rely on spiritist practices for treating sicknesses as well as for defense against mental illness and harm from spirits. Pray that God would work among the Pendalungan people and that a church planting movement would begin and grow. Pray that there would be national Christian workers willing to take the gospel to the Pendalungan people. Pray that God's Word would be easily available and readily received. Pray that many of the Pendalungan would turn to Jesus Christ and desire a relationship with Him.

Mahishya/Sogdop of India (South Asia)

The Mahishya or Sadgop people are also known as Chasa or Chasi. They live in West Bengal and surrounding states. The titles they use are Sarkar, Roy, Majumdar, Biswas, Mallik, Khan and Mandal. Sadgop have several gotras such as Sandilya, Kashyap, Bharadwaj, Moudgulya and Alambayan. In the Varna system, they are known as Vaisyas and as the members of Nabashakha group. The name Sadgop is derived from the two Sanskrit words: 'Sad' means good and 'Gop' means milkman. They are believed to be the descendants of lord Krishna. The Sadgop are a land owning community. Agriculture is their traditional and primary occupation. Marriages are negotiated and monogamy is common among them. Married women have a significant role to play in the ritual performances. Pray that they will begin to doubt their Hindu ways and begin to seek the one true God. Pray for the salvation of the Sadgop people and that God will send several Christian workers among them to meet their spiritual and physical needs.

Malay of Malaysia (Southeast Asia)

The Malay of Peninsular Malaysia makeup the majority of the Malay peoples in Malaysia, Brunei, and Singapore. In Malaysia, people are classified as Malay by the federal constitution if they speak their national language, Bahasa Malaysia, practice Malay customs, and are followers of Islam. Islam was brought to Malaysia by Arabic and Indian traders many centuries ago, and the Malay people have come to embrace and ardently follow the Islamic faith. All Malay people are considered Islamic though levels of devotion to the religion are varied. Even those who half-heartedly follow Islam participate in the fasting month, and the Malay people of affluence will go on the pilgrimage to Mecca at least once if not many times during their lifetime. Pray that there would be a church planting movement take root among the Malay people and that they would be open to receiving the Gospel. Pray that there would be workers ready to reach out to the Malay and be committed to seeing them reached for Christ.
